It's Easy and Fun to Bid

1. UUCG members sponsor interesting events like themed dinners, game nights and other events with varied refreshments. Many include full dinners. These events are open to UUCG members, families and friends.
2. Members and visitors may offer bids for themselves, family members, and friends.
3. Every participant must have an assigned bidding number. These are posted in advance in the lobby. See Myron or Lisa for additional bidding numbers.
4. Bidding begins with bidding sheets posted in the lobby after the service on January 26. The bidding sheets are removed soon after the service on February 2.
5. Bids may be placed in person or emailed within the bidding period to Myron.
6. The top bids win seats at the table. The "It's Yours Bid" guarantees a seat.
7. All winning bidders receive a letter 1 week after the bidding closes. That's when payment is due.
8. Bidders are responsible for payment. If you can't attend then perhaps you can find someone else to take your place. Please notify the host if you can't attend or if you've found someone else to go.

Our condo is on a 2nd floor accessible only by stairs.

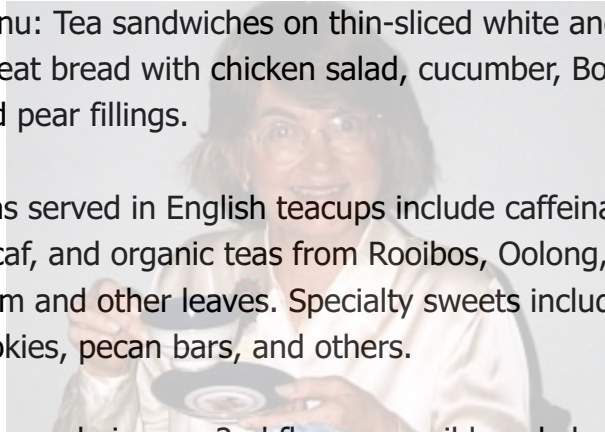

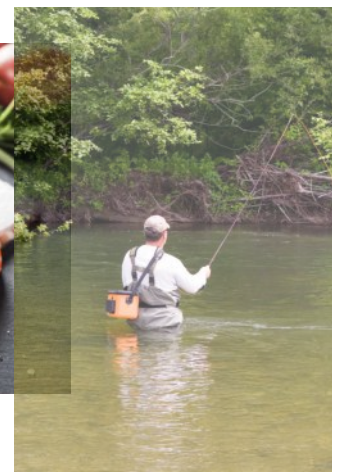

This is an extraordinary opportunity for you to explore shorebirds on Sea Island with an experienced ornithologist*. Discover differences among shorebirds, and get to better understand the effect of humans on shorebird nesting. You will have morning refreshments, a beach bird walk, and finish with a 3-course luncheon while observing land-based birds.

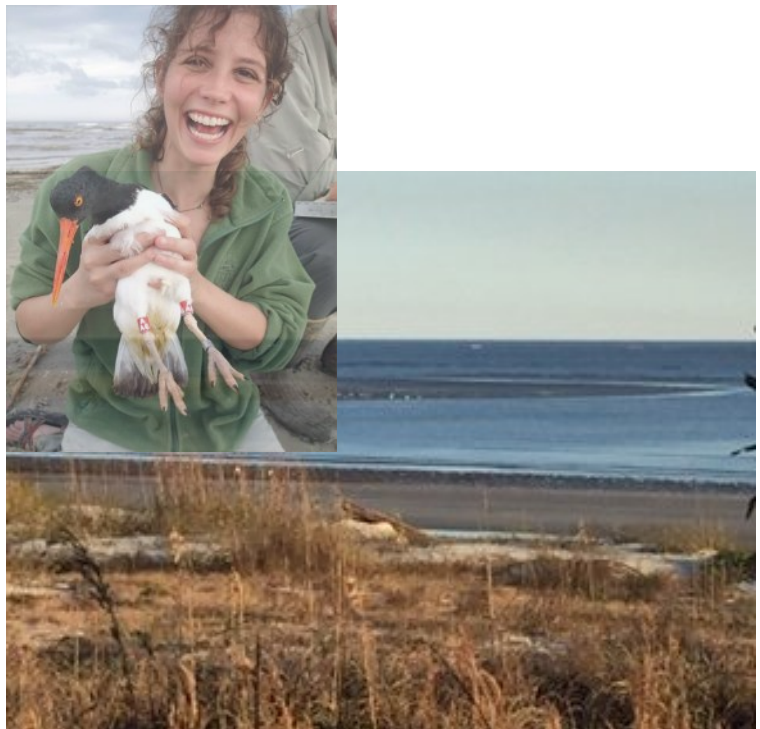
Join Ph. D. ornithologist Abby Sterling* for a morning of shorebird spotting on the beach bordering Ocean Forest Club at Sea Island. Later, Abby will identify birds visiting the native-plant backyard of Sally Revoile.

The morning will begin with refreshments provided on the pavilion of Ocean Forest clubhouse. From there, it is a short stroll to the beach for the walk to the north tip of Sea Island beach. During the leisurely one-half mile walk, sighting scopes (two available) will be positioned as shorebird congregations are encountered. Abby's identifications of shorebirds will include interesting information about their behaviors, migration, and nesting. Birding checklists will be distributed and identification aides will be available to guests. The total time spent walking the beach will be less than two hours.

Guests may return to Ocean Forest prior to completion of the group walk or may remain on the pavilion. Luncheon will be served at Sally Revoile's home.

*Dr. Sterling is a Shorebird Biologist with MANOMET, a Massachusetts-based non-profit focused on science-based solutions to environmental problems and making the world more sustainable, with a strong emphasis on recovering shorebird populations. She heads the Georgia Bight Shorebird Conservation Initiative and works to build networks of partners for research and management to improve shorebird habitats in Georgia and South Carolina.

Currently, Abby is working on several projects to study and reduce the conflicts between recreational beachgoers and nesting and feeding shorebirds along the SE coast.

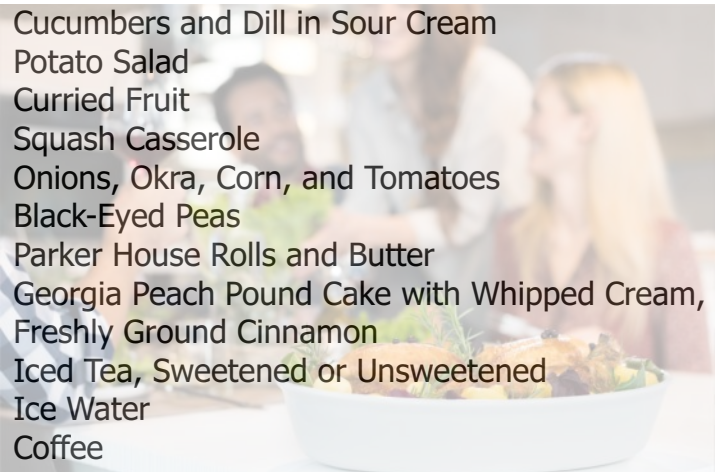
Southern Sunday Dinner
